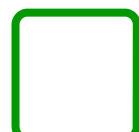
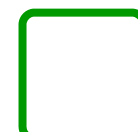
How Acts 16:5 Works

- Congregational pastors and leaders attend an introductory two-day seminar on September 26 and 27.
- The pastor and an Acts 16:5 team of up to six participants from the congregation attend seven more equipping events over the next three years—one every six months.
- The congregation's leadership team meets a minimum of eight times each year to design, implement, and assess the work to which God has called the church.
- The pastor meets at least four times each year with other pastors engaged in Acts 16:5 for encouragement and accountability in the Acts 16:5 process.

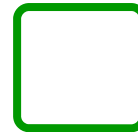
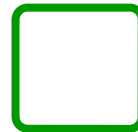


What Acts 16:5 Provides
